



Code of Conduct for Regency Bible School of Ministry and Missions

This Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for student behavior at Regency Bible School of Ministry and Mission. We are a community committed to academic excellence, spiritual growth, and Christ-like character. This code applies to all students, both on and off campus, as representatives of the school. Adherence to this code is essential for maintaining a positive and productive learning environment.

I. Spiritual Life:

- * **Personal Devotion:** Students are encouraged to cultivate a personal relationship with God through prayer, Bible study, and participation in corporate worship.
